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TRANSCRIPT

(This transcript is based on the recording of the prayer meeting. Some scriptures may be paraphrased or quoted from memory, and there may be minor discrepancies due to transcription limitations. Edits have been made for clarity, but the transcript aims to honor the prayer leader's words and intent.)

Good morning everyone that's here, that's coming with an expectation, that's believing for breakthroughs in their life, trusting God, and not leaning on their own understanding. But God, we're entering into your courts with thanksgiving and praise. We're entering into your courts believing, hallelujah, that prayer changes things.

We're entering into your courts, Father God, with an expectation. This morning, as I was just listening, the Holy Spirit said the first thoughts that many have, that the enemy comes at them with, are negative. And God is saying, why don't you just choose positive? Why don't you just choose my word? Why don't you just choose what I have for you? Because I don't have defeat in me. Hallelujah. I don't have fear. I don't give you fear. I don't give you lack. I don't give you negativity. I give you abundance. Hallelujah. That's what God was just saying to me. He says, "I give you abundance." He says, "I give you peace when your mind is trying to be overcome with depression, stress, or anxiety about what you should do." And God says, "I tell you that I give you peace of mind." Hallelujah. That peace is beyond the world. I give you peace in the name of Jesus.

So my expectation this morning for everybody that's in this prayer room, my expectation is that whatever God is saying to you, whatever God says to you during prayer today, whatever God says to you throughout the day, that your expectation shall be in God. Our confidence shall be in God, not in anyone else, not even in yourself. Your confidence shall be in God. Because God says, "Why would you choose death when I tell you to choose life? Why would you choose lack?" Hallelujah. That is not going to happen when God says, "I tell you to choose abundance." So why are you choosing these things? In me, I only give out abundance. I only give out love. I only give out strength in your weakness. This is what the Lord is saying to us today.

This is how we fight our battles: through praise and worship and knowing that he is a rewarder of those who diligently seek him. Hebrews 11:6 says, "Without faith, it's impossible to please God. He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek him." So God, in this prayer room, we're diligently seeking you with expectations. We're diligently seeking you, Father God, to guide and lead our steps.

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You can't lead nobody else. You can be pumped up for God. You could be like, "God, I'm in it." And you want somebody to come along with you, right? You want somebody to be in agreement with you. But God says that Emmanuel is with you. He never leaves you nor forsakes you. That is a promise. When friends forsake you, hallelujah, when your family forsakes you, God says, "I am with you always."

This is how we're fighting our battle, according to the word of God. Our confidence should not even be in ourselves. Our confidence shall be in God. And that's why it's important to spend time with God. That's why it's important that when you seek God's power, when you seek God's authority, you know that the confidence is not in you; the confidence is in God today.

How can I be depressed when my God is saying that "I have given you peace today"? So I will choose peace. I will fight and hold on to peace until I have peace. I will fight and hold on and claim, through the word of God, that I have peace in the name of Jesus.

1 Peter 5:7. We're talking today in the prayer room about faith in God—confidence in knowing that when we diligently seek Him, He will reward us. He will answer us. So my confidence is not in me because I fail myself many times. Hallelujah. I fail me when I say I'll do this and then I don't. Paul tells us all the time in the word of God, he says, "I want to do right, but wrong is already there, presenting itself to me."

Why is it always a challenge for me to choose faith? Why is it always a challenge to believe God over what I see—over my circumstances? I have to choose to believe the word of God. So today we're going to talk about 1 Peter 5:7. He says, "Give all your worries." Not just a little bit—like, "God, I got this right here." No, He says, "Give all your concerns."

Give all your cares to me—the big and the small. We want to come to God when it's big things that we're worried about or when we don't have the answer. But God simply tells us in 1 Peter 5:7, "Give me all your concerns. Give me all your doubts." Hallelujah. Give it all to me when you think that you can't. Give it all to me.

Because what is it that I do when I wake up in the morning? Philippians 4:13: I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. I say that, hallelujah, when I'm not feeling good. I say it when, "God, I don't feel like praying today." Because sometimes you don't feel like praying. So if you think every day that you wake up, I wake up and I'm ready to fight the battles, I'm waking up and I'm ready to pray—the answer to that is no.

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But out of obedience to the word of God, because He says, "Pray without ceasing," and out of obedience to the word of God, He says to trust in Him and lean not on your own understanding. I get up and I say, "When the devil is trying to bother me, hallelujah, when my thoughts are trying to tell me, 'No, stay in that bed. Stay here.'" You have moments like everybody else. I get up, and I choose the word of God.

That's why I can say, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." So when I'm weak, His strength is in me to do what He has called me to do, anointed me to do. That's why it's easy for me to get up and say, "I can do all things through Christ," when I don't feel well. When depression wants to hit my mind—hallelujah. When it's like, "What am I going to do here in this area, God?" I have to trust You. My confidence has to be in You.

So 1 Peter 5:7 says, "Give all your cares to God." Why? Because God says He cares about you. He's so faithful. That's why our confidence has to be in Him.

Psalms 17:6 says, "I am praying to you." This is what David is saying to the Lord. He says, "I'm praying to you because I know you will answer." He didn't say when He was going to answer. He didn't say how He was going to do it. He says, "I am praying to you, God, because I know you will answer me. Give me your ear, God, and listen because I'm praying to you."

So when you come into this prayer room, I want you to believe God—that I am praying, we are praying. And whatever needs you have, He will answer you with instructions. As He said, it's chaos all over the world. It seems like the people that are evil—it seems like the people that are doing wrong—it seems like the people that don't care—it seems like they're winning.

But it's nothing new. Habakkuk is talking to God. That's how we communicate. But he says, "But God, I know." He says, "It seems like they're winning, but I know you have an answer." It ties with Psalm 17:6. I know you have an answer, and when you answer me, you're going to have expectations out of me.

And sometimes God is instructing you to do something. Sometimes God is just saying, "Hey, I need you to believe. Once you start believing, I'll give you more instructions. But I need you to get doubt out of the way. I need you to get fear out of the way. I need to help you get out of yourself. I need you to get out of that."

And the word of God is saying—this is what Habakkuk said—He says, "I know God is going to answer me." Thank you, Holy Spirit. Because this was not in my prayer, but Habakkuk comes and he says (it connects with Psalm 17:6: *"I'm praying to You because I know You will*

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answer.") and Habakkuk said the same thing. He says, "God, I'm coming to You with my complaints. I'm coming to You with my concerns. I have been faithful to You. I have been telling the people all the things that You want me to do, but we are failing. It looks like we're not going to make it. But I'm praying to You because I know You're going to answer me."

And this is what God said to Habakkuk: *"Write the vision. Make it plain and clear. Write it upon your tablets."* He says, *"Though it tarries, keep trusting in Me. Keep having your confidence in Me. Keep believing in Me."* He says, *"So, write the vision. Make it plain and clear upon the tablets."* Hallelujah. And when you do that, it will come to pass.

It's like Jabez said. He's asking God to bless him indeed—in the midst of a storm, in the midst of chaos in his life. But he chooses to ask God, *"Bless me indeed, God. Enlarge my territory, that Your hand will be with me and keep evil away from me."* This is what Jabez is asking. This is what David is asking God. He said, *"I'm praying to You."*

Psalm 17 says, *"I'm praying to You because I know You will answer with instructions, with encouragement."* Hallelujah. You will answer me in a way that I will be obedient to Your word.

Hebrews 10:23 says, *"Let us hold tight. Hold on to My word without wavering. Hold on to faith."* Oh my God. Hold on to faith. Affirm your faith. Affirm your hope—not in your boss saying, *"I'm going to give you this promotion."* Not in the doctor's report. But God says, *"Listen, I'm telling you to have your hope and faith in Me because I will answer you. I'm going to affirm it."*

God says, *"You can trust Me with the promise. I'm going to keep My word to you."* I love it.

Ephesians 3:12 says, *"Because of Christ and our faith in Him..."* Here we go again. We've got David—hallelujah. We've got Jabez—hallelujah. We've got Moses putting their trust in God. We've got the Hebrew brothers Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. We have them in the fiery furnace. And who is their confidence in? Their trust is in God.

So this is what we're doing in the breakthrough prayer room today. We're putting our trust and confidence in God. Because I'm telling you, your mind is tricky. Your mind—hallelujah—will hear something. Because faith comes by hearing and hearing. That's why God says, *"Be careful of what you're listening to."* God is saying faith comes by hearing, and hearing the word of God—not the television, not social media, not motivational speeches.

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God is saying, *"Faith comes by hearing, and when you hear My word, you will be like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. You will be like Moses. You will be like..."* Hallelujah. That's who you'll be like. But your trust, faith, and confidence must be in Me.

So He says, *"Hold on to it."* And I'm telling you, I have to hold on to it. Even when I'm praying for others and believing for others, I hold on to the word of God. *"Father, strengthen their faith that they may believe and have confidence in You, Father."*

Your word is so powerful. Your mighty word says that You cannot lie to us. *"Strengthen my faith when I'm weak. Strengthen my faith when I don't know what to do. But I know You have an answer."* These are the prayers I pray to God. I know that You have the answer for me.

Christ is faithful. It says in Ephesians 3:12: *"Because of Christ and faith in Him..."* Here we go again—*"...and faith in Him, we can now come boldly and confidently into God's presence."*

When you're coming to God, when you're believing Him, when you're trusting Him, you are coming boldly. That's why when I'm praying, I come boldly with thanksgiving. That's why I come boldly to tell fear, *"You don't belong to me."* It's a spirit. When doubt tries to come, I tell it, *"You don't belong to me."* It's a spirit. Hallelujah.

When my finances are attacked, I say, *"You don't belong to me."* Because God says in His word that He will do exceedingly, abundantly more than I can imagine. All I do is speak the word. That's why it's so important throughout the day. That's why it's important that you make time for God.

If you make time for social media, if you make time to go to work, if you make time for your children, make time for God—because God becomes everything that we need.

So, we're going to stand on the watch, as Habakkuk said. We're going to stand. And when we've done all to stand, we're going to stand, knowing that God will answer us. I love it.

Lord Jesus, I'm giving you the word. Isaiah 26:3: *"You will keep me in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You because they trust in You."* I can only get peace when I trust in God. I can only get peace because He inhabits the praises of His people when I worship Him.

I can only get peace, hallelujah, when my confidence is in God. Stop putting your confidence in your ability or your talents. Put your confidence in God. He's a way maker. He's a promise keeper. He's light in the darkness all day long, in the name of Jesus. Today, You are in this place. Holy Spirit, You're in this atmosphere. I love it because God says, *"I will keep you in perfect peace."*

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He says in Psalm 56:3-4, *"But when I am afraid..."* So God knows you get afraid. Come on, y'all. Psalm 56:3-4—I'mma stay here for a minute. *"When I am afraid, I will put my trust in You. I will praise You because I know You keep Your promise."*

The promise is not in your ability. The promise is not in your talents. The promise is in God. Do you know that I know God will heal me? No matter what the circumstances look like, no matter what tests or trials come, God is a healer. God can deliver you from drugs. It's no different than delivering you from stress, anxiety, and worry. He can heal you from cancer. He can heal—listen to me—He can heal, hallelujah.

This is His promise. He says, *"When you are afraid, come to Me."* Going back to 1 Peter 5:7, *"Cast all your anxiety on Me because I care for you."* All your worries, all of your doubts, all the things that you are going through—come to Me.

And I want you to believe and have your confidence in Me. So, I'm going to put my trust in You. God says, *"I promise you, I will never fail you. I promise you, I'll never forsake you. I promise you, I'll never leave you. I promise you, I didn't give you the spirit of fear. I promise you, I didn't give you depression. I didn't give you doubt."*

I promise you—why is this happening to me? God says in Jeremiah, *"I promise to bless you indeed, exceedingly and abundantly."* I promise you that the word of God says, *"The confidence that I have in you is that if you ask anything in My name, I will do it."*

I promise you, in Mark 11:23-24, *"When you pray, believe that you receive whatever you ask for, and it will be yours."* Because my confidence is in God.

He says, *"I trust in God, so why should I be afraid? If I lose my job, what can it do to me? Hallelujah. If my children forsake me, what can it do to me?"*

Stop trying to please everybody. Why don't you choose to please God? Because God says He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

This is how I fight my battles—with praise. This is how I fight my battles—by putting on the whole armor of God. This is how I fight my battles—by trusting Him. This is how I fight my battles—knowing that my confidence is not in me, but my confidence is in my God.

This is how I fight my battles, knowing that He is going to do exceedingly, abundantly more. My expectation is in His power. My expectation is not in doubt. My expectation is that my God shall supply all my needs. My expectation is that the word of God says, *"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."*

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The word of God says that, hallelujah. Why are you fearing that you won't have breakthroughs? When I tell you to trust in Me, cast your worries, cast your cares. I choose—hallelujah—I choose God in the name of Jesus today. I choose His abundance. I choose His power. I choose Him in my weakness. I choose Him as my healer.

I choose that I can lay hands on the sick and they shall recover because I believe the word of God. I choose the power of the Holy Spirit as evidenced in my life. I choose happiness over pain. Hallelujah. I choose Him—over and over and over again. I choose the word of God.

He said, *"In Me, your confidence must remain."*

He says, *"Don't worry about how you're going to pay your bills. Don't worry about how you're going to make it this Christmas."* Hallelujah. *"If you're feeling lonely, don't worry about it. I am with you. Pray to Me. Ask Me. Have confidence in the word of God today."*

I believe these signs will follow Margarite. Remember, I tell you to put your name in it. I believe these signs will follow Margarite: I will cast out demons. I will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover because the power of God is in me. Hallelujah.

My confidence is in God—that when I lay hands on someone, when I speak the word, when I pray over someone—that God, You will do it. My confidence is that God says, *"One can chase a thousand, but two can put ten thousand to flight."*

My confidence is that You will deliver the word with power and authority. The authority of the anointing of God, His peace—hallelujah—His anointing—hallelujah—because my faith is in You. This is how I fight my battles. This is how we have these breakthrough prayers. This is how we have joy over negativity. I'm choosing what God says.

Imagine the three Hebrew boys. Imagine Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. It was time. You are not going to curse your God. You're not going to follow the instructions of man. They said, *"No, I'm going to trust my God. You put me in this furnace. You put me in this sickness—I'mma trust my God."*

Everybody is hollering about grocery bills or hollering about gas prices, but I trust my God. Hallelujah. I trust my God. And that's what the Hebrew boys did. They trusted God. So finally, they went into that furnace. They went in there trusting that—hallelujah—*"I'm either going to go to heaven, or God is going to deliver me."* Either way, it doesn't matter. Why? Because I trust in God. He is my strength.

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But we know how the story ends. We know that in that fiery furnace, Jesus came, and they were not harmed—their clothes, their shoes, their hair, their bodies. Why? Because God was with them.

God's confidence was with Moses when he had to cross the Red Sea. Hallelujah. His confidence was not in *how* they were going to do it. Moses' confidence was in God. How are we going to cross over? And God opened up the sea. He opened it up so they could pass through.

And that's what God wants us to have today. Whatever Red Sea you're facing in the name of Jesus, whatever fiery furnace you're facing, God says, *"Put your confidence in Me, knowing that I will reward you because you are diligently seeking Me."*

I need you to get this in the prayer room: Your confidence cannot be in your job. Your confidence can't be in money. Remember, money takes wings and flies, and you'll keep chasing it. Your confidence has to be in obedience. Your confidence has to be in God.

It says, *"I trust in God."* So why would I be afraid? Hallelujah. Why would I be afraid? That means fear is going to come. That means doubt is going to come because of the report. Some of y'all are worried: *"Can I do this? I just went through surgery. I just went through a financial attack. How am I going to do this? God, I want to go to the next level—how am I going to do that?"*

And as soon as you think that, fear comes. But God is saying, *"I need you to have your confidence in Me."* Say, *"No, I choose life. I choose that I can do all things through Christ."*

I choose abundance. I choose that when I'm weak, I'm going to glorify God. Right now, when I don't feel like praying, I choose to pray. Hallelujah. When I don't feel like standing on the promises of God, I choose anyway—because it's a choice.

And every time, He tells us in 1 Peter 5:7, *"Give Me your cares."* In Psalm 17:6, *"I'm praying to You because,"* as David says, *"I know You will answer me."* In Hebrews 10:23, *"I'm going to hold on tight to the word of God. I will not waver."* When doubt comes—it's a lie. I will not waver.

This is how I fight my battles: with praise, with worship, with hope, with peace, with love, with joy, with power, with the anointing. This is how I fight my battles. None of this is mine—all of it belongs to God. Hallelujah.

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This is how I fight my battles. Proverbs 3:5-6 says, *"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will direct your path."* I know He's going to direct my path. I know that He's going to direct my children. I know that if you're believing for children, if you're believing to get married, this is how I trust in God.

I'm going to stay close to Him. This is how I'm going to walk by faith. Hallelujah. I'm going to trust in Him. I'm not going to lean on my own understanding. This is how I'm going to stay in God.

Isaiah 26:3 says, *"He will keep me in perfect peace."* Why? Because my trust is in Him.

And you've got to fight. This is how we fight our battles—like Habakkuk. It looks like there's chaos everywhere. It looks like things are not going to happen in my favor. It looks like everything is falling apart. But I trust in the confidence of God. It doesn't matter, even down to the last second—God is going to come through for my family, for my children, for my husband.

God is going to come through for whatever you need. That's how you've got to be confident in God: *"You're going to come through for me."*

Right now, I may not have peace. But if I keep coming to You, if I keep saying Your name, if I keep praising, that peace is going to pass my understanding.

If you've lost a loved one, that peace is going to come. *Weeping may endure for a moment, but joy comes in the morning. Weeping may endure for an hour, but God says joy comes in the morning when you stick with Him. Joy comes when you lean not on your own understanding. Joy comes when your confidence is in God.*

In Psalm 56:3-4, it says, *"I will not be afraid. I will put my trust in You."* When you put your trust in yourself, you get defeated because you can only go so far. I've been doing this—hallelujah—since I was in my 20s, and I can tell you, you can only go so far. But when you put your trust and faith in God, He does miracles, signs, and wonders. Hallelujah!

When you're praying, not just for yourself but for others just as much as you're praying for yourself, you know that God will come through. Our confidence is in God.

This is what the breakthrough prayer is about today: my confidence in God. No more worries, no stress, no anxiety. When it comes, I'm going to stand like Shadrach, Meshach,

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and Abednego. I'm going to stand like Moses, Jacob—hallelujah! I'm going to stand on the promises of God today.

Margarite, give your worries to God. Jonathan, give all your worries to God. Hallelujah. Lorraine, put your trust in Him. Minister, Prophet—give your worries and cares to God. Do not be afraid, says the Word of God. *"Trust in Me. Keep your confidence."*

So here we are in this breakthrough prayer room. Father, I believe the people are ready. They're ready to receive, Father God, knowing that their confidence is in You.

They will put their name in the Word of God in 1 Peter 5:7. Margarite, don't worry. They're going to put their trust in God, as it says in Psalm 17:6, *"I'm praying to You because I know You will answer me."* Margarite, hold tightly onto God's Word. Jonathan, don't waver. Daria, keep your faith in Him. Keep saying the Word of God. Lorraine, keep speaking it over your health: *"I will not be afraid. I'm going to hold tightly to God."*

Because of Ephesians 3:12, *"Because of Christ and the faith I have in Him—not in me."* Every bill is paid. Every need is met in my household. That's how you have to declare it: *"Every bill, every need—whatever it is—in that new position, my confidence is in God."*

I'm going to put those résumés out there. If you're starting a business, your confidence must be in God to put the right people in your life. Thank you, Lord Jesus!

I need healing—hallelujah. My confidence is not in me. I'm going to saturate myself in the Word of God today. Margarite, trust in the Lord. Lean not on your own understanding.

So I choose today. Amazing things are going to happen to me today. Hallelujah. I choose today that I'm blessed to be a blessing. I choose today that I can lay hands on the sick and they shall recover. I choose today that when doubt comes, I'll choose life. I'll choose the promises of God.

When worry comes, I will choose healthy spiritual wholeness in God. I'm going to choose that today—hallelujah. I'm going to choose that when I'm afraid, when I don't want to do something, I will choose to put my trust in God.

There's a song that says, *"I trust in God, my Savior. He will never fail."* They're singing that scripture. Psalm 56:3-4 says, *"I put my trust in Him. I will praise God for His promises. I will trust in God. So why should I be afraid?"*

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Margarite, don't you be afraid of the things that are trying to come at you. When you're praying for other folks, fiery darts come from the east, west, north, and south. I speak to it every single day. I am healed.

My legacy is the power of prayer, faith, and abundance. My legacy is that I am doing exceedingly, abundantly more than I can imagine through God who strengthens me. In my weakness, His power will manifest.

So our confidence today is in You, God. I will not throw away my confidence in You, God.

I pray that every person on this prayer line has their confidence in You. They have their trust in You. They are like Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego, and Daniel. They are like David with Goliath.

My trust and faith are in You. Who is this Philistine giant trying to come against the army of Israel? And David said, *"Who is this that's coming against my God?"* My trust is in God. He defeated Goliath.

This is where our confidence has to be—in God—that He *will* do it.

So, on this prayer line, I thank You that our confidence is in God. If you're suffering in any way, put your confidence in God. Know that He is a healer. Know that He is a deliverer. Know that He will pay all of your bills. Know that He can do debt cancellation.

Know that when you've made a mistake, He is a forgiving God. Know that He will correct you when you're wrong. But put your confidence in Him.

So God, as we end this prayer—though we enter and end—it will be the beginning and the end: the Alpha and Omega. Breakthrough! Confidence in God, my Savior, who will never fail me.

In the name of Jesus today—I don't know about you—but today, I am blessed by this Word. I am thanking God that my confidence is in Him. I am thanking God—hallelujah—that He's doing today what He's going to do: something exceedingly, abundantly above what I can imagine.

I am thanking God today that every person on this prayer line will be a blessing to someone else today. Every need will be met—hallelujah. Every thought, their minds will be saturated with this declaration: *"I will trust in God. My confidence will be in God today."*

And every day moving forward, I will spend some time with Him so my confidence can continue to be built up. No matter what attacks me, I know to run to Him—not to fear, not to doubt. It's not going to happen.

I won't be anxious for anything, but with prayer, supplication, and thanksgiving, I'm letting my requests be made known unto God, and my confidence is in Him.
