I CAN DO ALL THINGS THROUGH CHRIST WHO STRENGTHENS ME! PHIL. 4:13

SCRIPTURES

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TRANSCRIPT

(This transcript is based on the recording of the prayer meeting. Some scriptures may be paraphrased or quoted from memory, and there may be minor discrepancies due to transcription limitations. Edits have been made for clarity, but the transcript aims to honor the prayer leader's words and intent.)

We're entering into the breakthrough prayer room knowing that God, Hallelujah, that God is for me - Who can be against me? As we surrender to the name of Jesus today, Your anointing this morning, I welcome you this morning. Most importantly, we thank God for waking us up this morning. We thank God for we are up and able to communicate with one another, able to talk with one another, able to come in on this prayer line, having expectations of breakthroughs to grow with you, Father God. For you to cleanse us this morning, Hallelujah. For you to, Father God, cleanse us in our minds, in our bodies, in our spirit, Lord Jesus.

We are coming to you this morning, knowing you are faithful, you are powerful, Father God. So, I'm welcoming you in this prayer room. I'm welcoming you today for breakthroughs in the name of Jesus today. I'm excited because He moves powerfully. When the Holy Spirit comes into the atmosphere, Hallelujah, strongholds are broken in the name of Jesus.

I need you to hear and understand that strongholds are broken in the name of Jesus today. It doesn't matter what circumstances. It doesn't matter what's going on in the world. **You have to keep your faith anchored and grounded in the Word of God today.** So, here we are in the breakthrough prayer room, Hallelujah. And first thing, I give glory to God. I thank Him that He uses me as a vessel. I thank Him that His power moves mightily through me in the name of Jesus. I thank you, Father God, as I believe and come in agreement with every person that's on this prayer line, Father God, that You, Holy Spirit, are welcome here.

This morning, the Holy Spirit said, "I know your name, Hallelujah. I know your name." Hallelujah. He says, "You tell the people today that I know them in the name of Jesus today." Hallelujah. It may be other people that don't recognize you, Hallelujah, but **God recognizes your value.** And what's most important is that **God knows your name in the name of Jesus** today, that His glory and His power are present. When I tell you, I'm fired up and ready. I'm ready. Hallelujah. Because I know no weapon formed shall prosper against anybody that's in this prayer room in the name of Jesus. Today, **we're ready to fight the good fight of faith.**

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We're ready to come powerfully in this breakthrough room with expectations, knowing that my God will supply all our needs according to the riches and glory that's in Christ Jesus. I thank you this morning, Father God, that your Word says, **"Be anxious for nothing, but with prayer and supplication, let our requests be made known unto You."** So today, Father God, in the breakthrough prayer room, I thank you for being the **comforter**. I thank you for being the **healer**, for being the **deliverer**. I thank you for being the protector. I thank you, Father God, that **your grace is sufficient today**. I thank you, Father, that **strongholds will be broken** in the name of Jesus today. Whatever anyone came in with, Hallelujah, they will be delivered. Hallelujah.

I'm welcoming the Word of God in our lives today. Hallelujah. I'm welcoming the power of God in our lives today. Hallelujah. Because if you don't welcome God into the presence, Hallelujah, He's not going to come on the scene unless you call upon Him. And we are calling upon the name of Jesus today, that He hears His children. Hallelujah. Because He says the righteous will never be forsaken or begging for bread today. I'm coming fired up today. I'm coming in this prayer room, Hallelujah, because He says come boldly to the throne. Because the Word of God is so powerful today. The Word of God, Hallelujah, is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

So, welcome to the breakthrough prayer room. Hallelujah. I thank you, Father. As I start off, I declare Philippians 4:13: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" in the name of Jesus. And you put your name there. God is saying not only does He know your name, but you can do all things through Christ who strengthens you.

And so, God, by your anointing right now, as I stated, there's a lot going on in the world. But I have good news today: If you hold on to God, Hallelujah, and you trust in God, He's a way maker. Hallelujah. He is a father to the fatherless in the name of Jesus. He's a doctor. He's a healer for those that need to be healed spiritually, mentally, physically—it doesn't matter. There's power in the name of Jesus. I want to say that again: There is power in the name of Jesus. There is no temptation, test, or trial that God has not made a way of escape for.

So, I'm coming to encourage you today to be an overcomer. To be an overcomer in the faith of God. To be an overcomer, declaring that no circumstances, no person, will stand in your way.

I will not allow the cares of the world to choke me and stop me from walking in faith and victory. We often think we're not supposed to face tests, trials, or tribulations, but God says, "Be of good cheer. I have overcome trials, tests, and tribulations." When you stay close to

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Him, when you draw near to Him, His Word helps us overcome. We overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony.

So, I'm here because, during this time, we celebrate Jesus' birthday. We're coming into Christmas next week, and though it's a celebration, people are still going through tests, trials, and tribulations. God wanted me to tell you today, Hallelujah, that He knows your name. He knows that you are faithful.

And when you are faithful, He knows your name through His strength. This is the evidence we have through the Word of God: He gives us wisdom. He gives us power. He says, "You have the power." Jonathan has the power. Lorraine has the power. God says you have the power. He's given you the authority. Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven. Whatever you loose will be loosed in heaven.

As I pray, as I communicate, and as I receive calls from people, I keep saying this: You have to believe the Word of God more than anything. You have to believe God more than you believe yourself.

You have to believe God more than you believe the circumstances or the tests or trials that you're facing. You have to believe God. I have crossed over with God, and no weapon formed against me shall prosper. He says we are more than overcomers. That's what He wants me to tell you today. We are to overcome any situation or test or trial that challenges us. We are more than overcomers in Christ Jesus today.

As I stated, I'm fired up. Why? Because the devil has been trying to come against me. And I want to tell him today that he's a liar. Yesterday, I told him that he's defeated. I will not let anyone, any situation, or any circumstance take me out of who I am in Christ Jesus. Why? Because you know the tree by its fruits. What fruits are you producing according to the Word of God today?

My God says that you are an overcomer. My God says that every need in your life will be met. My God says that no weapon formed against you shall prosper. So, as I ask the Holy Spirit into this breakthrough prayer room, I'm declaring that breakthroughs are powerful as people learn what to pray for and how to stand on the Word of God today. He says to tell them that they are more than overcomers.

Nahum 1:7 says, "The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble. He knows those who take refuge in Him." The problem is, people don't take refuge in Christ Jesus. They take refuge in themselves. They take refuge in other people, with friends, or with family. But

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God says, "The Lord is good. He's a stronghold in the day of trouble. He knows those who take refuge in Him."

So, I take refuge in the Word, and I saturate myself in it more and more until nothing else matters except the Word of God. Nothing else matters except that I move and have my being in the Word of God because there is power in the name of Jesus. His name is above all names.

Holy Spirit, as we celebrate Jesus, as we celebrate, Father God, that He was born—Hallelujah—we give You praise. Hallelujah! Through Your Word, we declare that we are more than overcomers because You said we should walk by faith. Hebrews 11:1 says, "Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

Hebrews 11:6 says, "Without faith, it's impossible to please God. He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." So, Father, as we seek You and trust You, I'm standing in faith. I'm not moved by my situation. How can I be an overcomer in this breakthrough prayer room? I must stay in faith. I must speak in faith. I must seek faith above everything else because the Word of God says, "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing the Word of God."

I know you have to go to work. I know you have to deal with people. I know different things are going on in your life. But the Word of God says what you hear will guide you. It will order your steps. And the only way I know I'm an overcomer, the only way I have confidence in God, is to stay in His Word. Hallelujah.

To let Him know, to show me how to be an overcomer, to show me how to diligently seek Him throughout the day. When circumstances try to take hold of my mind or heart, or when people try to challenge me, Hallelujah, I know that my God says I am more than an overcomer. He says, "Take refuge in Me." Hallelujah. You have to know how to take refuge in God. You have to understand that it doesn't matter—we have access to the Word 24/7. You can get it on the radio, through YouTube, podcasts, or other platforms. We have access like never before to the Word of God. That's why God is saying, "Take refuge."

What are you hearing? Because what you are hearing will determine how you act when facing tests, trials, and tribulations. What are you hearing? The enemy is coming to challenge you, but God says, "I so loved the world that I gave My only begotten Son." So why can't we give back to God and be the example He has called us to be as disciples?

He says in 2 Corinthians 4:8-9, "We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed."

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What is God saying there? He's telling you that you're an overcomer. You may be afflicted, Hallelujah.

You may be persecuted, people may talk about you or say different things—it doesn't matter. God says, "You are not forsaken because you are in Me. You will never be destroyed in Christ Jesus."

Here we are in this prayer room, mighty Father. He says in Psalm 138:7, "Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You preserve my life; You stretch out Your hand against the anger of my foes; with Your right hand You save me." He's going to protect you. He's going to stretch out His hands against anything coming against you. He will deliver you. You are an overcomer.

Stop being fearful. Stop listening to your own mind. Stop listening to people who go against what God says you can do. "You can do all things through Christ who strengthens you." Saturate yourself in the Word of God so your mind can be renewed. He says in John 14:1, "Let not your heart be troubled." That means don't let your mind be troubled. It doesn't matter if it's sickness, if your children aren't acting right, if you're having problems at work, or if you don't know what decisions to make—God says, "Let not your heart be troubled."

He tells you to believe. We're going to talk about this every time in the prayer room. God simply tells us to believe in Him. Hallelujah. Believe in Him. That's how your heart won't be troubled, and that's how your mind won't be in distress. When you are in distress, call upon the name of Jesus, and He hears you. He delivers you from everything—not just some things.

Sometimes, every hour, you need to call on the Lord. He will deliver you from all distress. He says, "Believe in Me." Romans 8:28 says, "And we know that in all things, God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose." You have to know and believe that God is working all things together for your good. It may not look like it, but you have to trust that you've done all you can do.

It's working out for your good. Why? Because God says He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. He never changes. Life may change, and we may get older, Hallelujah, but God never changes. He knows your name, and He knows He will bring you out on the other side. He just needs you to trust Him. He needs you to believe in Him.

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I saw a video of a pastor who said the Holy Spirit instructed him to go to his church dressed as a homeless man. He sat in front of his church, acting like he was homeless. He wanted to see how, as believers, we would act.

Jesus said there will be times you meet people who may be angels, and how you treat them reflects who you are. The pastor sat outside, dressed as a homeless man, while people passed him by on their way into church to get the Word for themselves. But God says, "Here is someone who needs help right now. He's outside."

Still, there were a few people who stopped, came up to him, and said, "God bless you."

The homeless person had a cup, and people began putting money in it. They started saying, "God bless you." They told him he could come in because it was cold. Little by little, children with their parents invited him, saying, "Hey, you can come inside." After everyone had entered the church, he walked in, still looking like a homeless man. Then, he began to take off the garments and other items he was wearing.

He said, "I want to thank God because, at first, people were just walking past me, not giving me any attention. But then, some people started paying attention. They began telling me about God, helping me, and giving to me. Some gave me water, and some said, 'Just come on in.'"

I'm sharing this because God says in His Word, "As you have done it unto another person, you have done it unto Me." We, as children of the Most High, must understand that to be overcomers in Christ Jesus, we first need to be like Jesus. We have to act like Jesus, walk like Jesus, and talk like Jesus, because God is looking at our hearts—not just our actions.

This is how we become overcomers in Christ Jesus. He says, "We know all things are working together for good." Why? Because I put my trust and faith in God. Why? Because if circumstances try to dictate something different, my God says, "Be anxious for nothing, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." Not to your mother, not to your father, not to your best friend, not to your spouse.

He says, "Let your requests be made known to God." In this prayer room, we are declaring that we are more than overcomers. We are saying, "I can do all things through Christ Jesus." We are saying, "I love Psalm 121:2: 'I lift up my eyes to the hills. Where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord.'"

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I'm telling you today: your help comes from the Lord. Don't be overwhelmed during this holiday season. Know that Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. If you need healing in your mind or body, know that God is there for you. If you are praying for a loved one, know that God says we are to pray for one another. This is how we overcome—by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony.

So here I am, declaring that my help comes from the Lord. Understand that breakthrough prayers are happening as we cross into 2025. My help comes from the Lord. It says in 2 Corinthians 1:3-4: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction."

He's telling you, "I will comfort you." When you are afflicted, when you feel like you have no answers, when the doctor's report doesn't align with what you are believing God for, He says, "I am the one who comforts you."

God is the only one who can come to your aid in your time of need and deliver you. He says, "I am delivering you from affliction so that you may abide in Me and be comforted in Me." Hallelujah! So, God, we thank You right now that we are more than overcomers. We thank You for the breakthrough prayers happening in this prayer room right now.

It doesn't matter what hardship you are facing. I want you to believe God right now in this prayer room because God says, "One can chase a thousand, but two can put ten thousand to flight." We are coming together to stand in faith and strengthen one another.

God says, "In your weakness, I will strengthen you." So we are in this breakthrough prayer room, interceding for one another, interceding for the world, interceding for the brokenhearted, interceding for those who need food, clothing, or shelter.

Here we are in this prayer room, God, believing in You. In our weakness, strengthen us. Help our children. Help the world. Help the nation. Why? Because God says, "You are an overcomer. Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

He says, "Simply believe."

So today, as I pray with you, I am believing not just for breakthroughs in finances, healing, and deliverance, but for everything you need to be delivered from. I don't know what you are facing, but God does. When you are in this breakthrough prayer room, know that nothing is impossible for God.

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So here we are, thanking You this morning. Praising You this morning, believing that throughout the day, every person hearing my voice will trust You more, will not be anxious for anything, but with prayer and supplication, will make their requests known to You, Father.

You, who hold all the power and glory, will deliver us from every distress. We are here asking for breakthroughs—not just for ourselves, but for others. Just as the pastor dressed as a homeless man was an example, we are called to be examples.

Hallelujah! We will feed the hungry. We will help the poor. We will assist those in distress during this holiday season. We will support those who feel lonely. Use us, Father God. We come with expectations, ready to be used by You like never before. We are focused on You.

We're focused on you, Father God, to guide us in the direction we need to go. We will trust you and lean not on our own understanding. We will acknowledge you in all our ways and ask you to direct our path. Holy Spirit, you are welcome here. Order our steps today as we trust in you. We thank you right now. Hallelujah. I pray, Father God, in the spirit and the natural for breakthroughs in this prayer room for every person here. Let them receive what they need, that your glory and anointing fill this place, fill our hearts, and fill our minds where your glory is manifested. We're here to hear from you, to be overcomers through your word, to trust in you like never before.

We trust in you and let go of ourselves, allowing you to interrupt our plans today, Father God, so that we may honor you and that your glory may be present with us. We humble ourselves mightily, trusting in you as you move and make a way. Right now, I say, thank you, Jesus. Thank you, Jesus, for breakthrough prayers. Thank you, Jesus, for power. Thank you, Jesus, for glory. Thank you for strengthening me. Thank you, Father God, for this atmosphere where every need is met, where every person on this prayer line is believing not only for themselves but also for others. They will bless others. It doesn't have to be a big gift; it could be a small one. But we are blessed to be a blessing during this Christmas season, during this atmosphere of giving.

We ask you, Father God, to help us be overcomers so that we can be blessed to be a blessing to others. We will seek your knowledge. We will seek your guidance. Deliver us from trials and tribulations. Deliver us, Father God, because your grace is with us, and it's more than enough today in this prayer room. Your word in Ephesians tells us that you will do exceedingly, abundantly more than we can imagine or think. If we think negatively, you can do exceedingly, abundantly more than that. So, we turn that switch on: "God is for me, who can be against me." We turn on the truth that God is working all things for my good.

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Your word in Psalms 138:7 says, "Though I walk in the midst of trouble, you will preserve my life." No sickness, no disease, and nothing can harm me because you will preserve my life. Your word assures us that though we are afflicted, we are not crushed. Though we may be perplexed, we are not in despair. Though we are persecuted, we are not forsaken. We must believe. Thank you, Lord Jesus, that even as we walk through the valley of the shadow of death, it will not harm us. We just have to walk through it, knowing that you, our God, will supply all our needs. And so, I am blessed to be a blessing to someone else. Amen.

I declare, "God, I receive that I am blessed to be a blessing to someone else in my trials and tribulations. What do you need from me, God? I want more of you, Jesus. I want more of your power, more of your glory. That's what I ask for daily. Lord, in my distress, use me so I can be a blessing to someone else." This is what breakthrough prayers are about. It's none of me and all of you, God. This atmosphere is charged. It's powerful. It's breaking strongholds. Before I joined this prayer line, I was binding depression. I was binding fear. I was binding deception, lies, and gaslighting. I told them they have no authority in my life or over my family.

I bind them in the name of Jesus because you have given me the power and authority. You have given us all the power and authority to believe. Even in disappointments and betrayals, you promise to preserve our lives in the face of our enemies. Last week, we remembered how you prepare a table for us in the presence of our enemies. You have anointed us to walk by faith and not by sight. You have anointed us to be overcomers and deliverers. So today, God, I thank you for this prayer room. I thank you for your blessings and your anointing, that we may be blessed to be a blessing.

Your word in Nahum 1:7 says, "The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; He knows those who take refuge in Him." So, we take refuge in you when we're afflicted, disappointed, or deceived, knowing that we will come out victorious in Christ Jesus. Your word assures us that even if we are forsaken, we will not be destroyed. Lord, we thank you today for that truth. We thank you that we are walking as overcomers, speaking victoriously and not in defeat. We are believing because your word says, "Call those things which are not as though they are."

If you're feeling depressed, remember that God says you are not depressed. He says, "Call those things which are not as though they are." If you are sick, declare, "I am healed." His word says, "Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; save me, and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise." Stop focusing on the problem. Be an overcomer. I bless your name right now, Holy Spirit. I bless your name, Father God, because we hear your word that we are overcomers. We are blessed to be a blessing, and we are going to celebrate Jesus. We're

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going to celebrate and be a blessing to others. We will not let our hearts be troubled. We will stand on your word and your promises.

I believe that every person hearing my voice will see every need met in their life. Call those things which are not as though they are. Call into existence what you need, for you are an overcomer. Eyes have not seen, and ears have not heard the greatness God has in store for you. He will never forsake you or leave you. There is power in the glory of God. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. Say it a hundred times if you have to: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."
